All three days of the event will take place at the usual dancing hall on Long Lane where we will rehearse and perform our show. We hope there will be two performances.

The Summer School will take place on the 27th, 28th and 29th of July, 10am-4pm for the first two days and 10am-6.00pm (approx.) on the last day to include the show. It costs £80 per child which includes snacks and drinks and your McDonalds Lunch. It is open to all members of the dancing school who are currently in year one and above.

★ We do hope you will join us for our 31st annual summer school, they just keep getting better and better and we are sure this year’s show won’t disappoint.

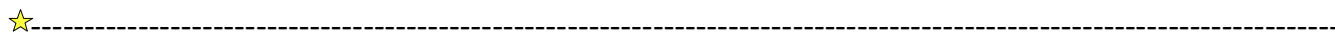

★ *My child is currently in reception but would like to join, is this possible?*

★ The reason it is year one and above is because the days are very long and the age range is vast, however if you would like a younger child to be put on a waiting list, please let us know.

★ *How do I buy tickets for the show?*

★ Tickets will go on sale at drop off and collection over the course of the 3 days. They will be £2 for adults and 50p for children.

★ You will need to pay in cash when buying the tickets. There will be limited seating available as the show is at the dancing hall and tickets will be on a first come, first served basis.

★ *What do I need to provide my child with?*

★ A packed lunch for the first two days, and a snack and a drink on the last day. Colouring bits and bobs. Hair stuff for the show day such as nets and pins as you did at The Beck Theatre show (we’ll do the hair). Some minimal costume may need to be provided if possible – for example last year we asked everyone to provide black leggings.
